Jaime Escalante was a math teacher in California. He became famous due to his success in teaching Calculus to students in Los Angeles. So many of his students passed the Advanced Placement exam that the Educational Testing Service suspected dishonest test-taking. Many of the students had to take the exam again, but they did pass. The movie “Stand and Deliver” is based on the story of his teaching. He was born in Bolivia. There he taught math for 12 years. Then he studied at the University of Puerto Rico, and in 1964 he moved to the United States to receive college degrees in electronics and mathematics.
